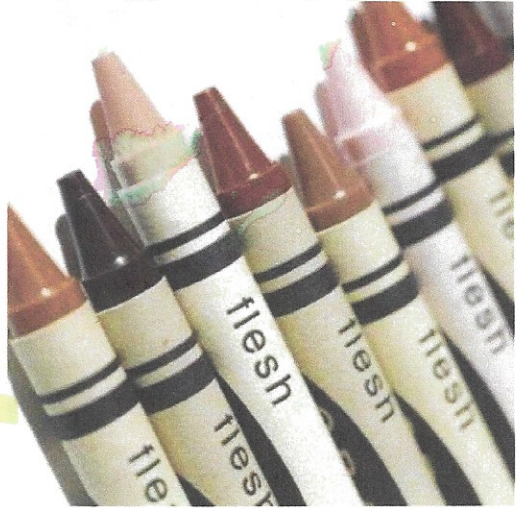


## \* Talking to White Kids About Race & Racism \* Horrible!
